Keller Army Community Hospital to hold Drug Take-Back Day

WEST POINT, N.Y. – Keller Army Community Hospital's Pharmacy Dept. will hold a 'Prescription Drug Take-Back' Day on Saturday, April 25, 2015, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., in the Hospital lobby.

Keller Army Community Hospital is located at 900 Washington Road, West Point, N.Y.

Take-Back Day is intended to provide a setting for individuals to dispose of unwanted and/or unused over-the-counter and prescription drugs, including controlled substances. This event is part of the effort to improve public health and safety by helping to prevent diversion, misuse, and abuse of the drugs by teens and others.

The take-back service is free and anonymous, with no questions asked. Keller Army Community Hospital will accept liquids, tablets, capsules, and all other forms of unwanted medication.

Keller Army Community Hospital wants to remind participants to PLEASE:

- turn in fluids in their original container
- remove personal identification information or cross out with a black marker

This event is open to the Greater West Point Area communities, including Cornwall, Highland Falls and Fort Montgomery.
