A SOLDIER'S PLEDGE

I _____, pledge that at all times while on

duty and off duty I will remain safety conscious.

I will absolutely take no unnecessary risk that may endanger my or another's life and prevent my or their safe return.

I will observe all State and on post traffic laws and be alert for warning signs. New York State law prohibits the use of cell phones while operating a motor vehicle unless a hands-free device is used.

I understand that headphones may not be worn by the operator of any vehicle, motorized or not, on the roadways of New York State, including West Point Military Reservation. In addition, I understand that using headphones when running, jogging, driving, cycling or using non-motorized vehicles is not permitted.

I understand that New York State law requires the operator of any motor vehicle (i.e., private, government or tactical) to wear a seat belt and ensure all front seat passengers wear seat belts whenever such vehicle is operated and seat belts are installed. I understand that seat belts are required for back seat passengers under the age of 10 and that child restraints are mandatory for children 4 years of age and younger or who weigh less than 40 pounds.

I will ensure that I and my passengers wear a helmet at all times while operating a motorcycle. I will ensure that I and my passengers wear a reflective vest at all times to ensure we are made highly visible to other traffic.

I will get a good nights rest before beginning a long driving trip.

I will take appropriate rest stops when driving for great distances and drive at safe speeds determined by weather and road conditions.

I will not consume alcoholic beverages while driving, boating, skiing, swimming, or whenever my physical reflexes and abilities are needed to prevent an accident.
