

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #15, Uniform and Appearance

1. References: AR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia  
West Point Message 2010-2-001 PT Uniforms
2. Duty uniform policy:
  - a. Wear of the appropriate duty uniform will be in accordance with AR 670-1 and this policy. For the purposes of this policy letter, the duty uniform is defined as the Army Combat Uniform (ACU).
  - b. Soldiers will remain in complete uniform at all times. Soldiers may remove their headgear while in or on a privately owned or commercial vehicle. The t-shirt is only acceptable as an outer garment when commanders specifically authorize it due to extreme heat.
  - c. The Garrison Commander has directed ACU sleeves down at all times unless otherwise directed. When in a field environment or during ceremonies, sleeves will be down. The only times you are authorized to wear the Improved Physical Fitness Uniform (IPFU) is when conducting physical fitness training or at medical appointments where the IPFU is the preferred uniform (ie, physical therapy).
  - d. The only prescribed headgear is the beret while in garrison.
  - e. Soldiers may wear the duty uniform while visiting off-post eating establishments, but will not consume alcohol while in uniform. The IPFU is not authorized in off post establishments.
  - f. Soldiers will not visit off-post drinking establishments (defined as a business whose primary source of income is the sale of alcoholic beverages, i.e. bars or clubs) while in duty uniform.
  - g. Wearing the duty uniform off-post is prohibited when bring discredit upon the Army or is inappropriate, such as loitering in video arcades, attending movie theaters, doing extended shopping in malls or other retail stores, and for any other recreational or leisure pursuits. Civilian clothing is the proper attire for leisure activities.
  - h. In accordance with West Point Message 2010-06-02-001, when conducting PT outdoors between 0530 and 0700 and during periods of limited visibility or inclement weather, the reflective belt will be worn around the waste. When wearing a jacket, sweatshirt, or other outer garment the reflective belt will be worn at reverse port arms (right shoulder to left hip).
