



BENEFICIARY ACCESS TO KELLER ARMY COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

When you have a scheduled appointment at Keller Army Community Hospital, you can access West Point at all three gates:

- Washington (closest to Keller) and Thayer Access Gates are open from 0600 to 2200.
- Stony Lonesome Access Gate is open 24 hours.

Everyone entering post must go through a COVID-19 screening.

At Stony Lonesome gate you will be asked the following questions:

1. Have you traveled to or through anywhere outside of the United States in the past 14 days?
2. Have you or someone you have been in close contact with been confirmed to have COVID-19?
3. Are you experiencing any of the symptoms of COVID-19, including high temperature, severe cough, shortness of breath, etc.?

Screenings at Thayer and Washington Gates will be conducted only through the **“LiveSafe” app** or **a printed copy of the health survey**. The app can be downloaded from the [App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#).

Surveys must be completed the day of your visit/day of requested access, and prior to your arrival at the access gate.
